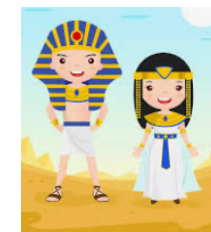




Ancient Egyptians

Label it or write a short paragraph explaining: • What it is • What it was used for • Who might have owned it	Hieroglyphic message Write your name or a short message using Egyptian hieroglyphs. Include: • The English translation • A background inspired by Ancient Egyptian art	A day in the life of an ancient Egyptian Write a diary entry or short story imagining a day as: • A child • A farmer • A pharaoh Include details about food, clothes, jobs, and the River Nile.	Build a mini pyramid Make a pyramid using recycled materials (cardboard, sugar cubes, Lego, etc.). Add a short explanation answering: • Why pyramids were built • Who was buried inside • Why they were important	Egyptian Gods & Goddesses Fact File Choose one Egyptian god or goddess. Create a fact file including: • Name and symbol • What they were god/goddess of • Why ancient Egyptians believed in them
